REGISTRATION

We would like each individual participant to submit a completed Registration Form along with a check payable to Wisconsin Academy for \$55 by February 28, which allows us to plan more effectively in ordering music and t-shirts etc. (The registration fee has increased this year due to cost increases over the past several years.) This can be accomplished individually or corporately through your school or church. The \$55 fee covers meals through Sabbath lunch, festival t-shirt, and other festival expenses. Sponsors will also need to complete the Sponsor Form and submit their payment of \$40 for a meal ticket. Parents coming for the concert may purchase Sabbath meal tickets (\$7.00 per meal per person) in advance by indicating which meals and enclosing additional money with their student's registration fees. Additional T shirts may be available for purchase at registration. Please plan on 1 sponsor for every 10 students, male and female sponsors are a must if you are bringing both male and female students. Please be sure to send in the 1) Student Registration Form, 2) Sponsor Registration Form and 3) Money to cover the festival costs. Remember the registration due date of February 28. (If you need to wait until later to send in the money, let us know. But, please return the registration forms by then if at all possible.)

NOTE - All registrations can now be completed online at "wisacad.org". Just follow the "Music" link under the "Learning" tab to Music Fest Information and Registration. Registrations must be completed online/or mailed in by February 28. Fees can be mailed in anytime before March 30, or turned in at time of registration on March 30.

MUSIC

All the church schools and churches will/can receive one copy of the festival music. You will be able to go to our website, "wisacad.org", to access links to recordings of music that you can use to help practice the songs and all of the registration materials. Please feel free to print copies of the music for your students, so they may begin preparing for the festival. You may use these in rehearsals to introduce the students to the music before they arrive on campus. We have ordered sheet music for the students once they arrive for the festival. Remember, the music (both originals and any copies made) are the property of Wisconsin Academy and must be returned at the end of the festival checkout.
